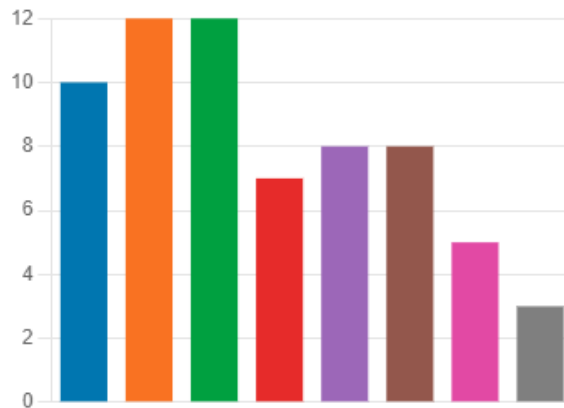

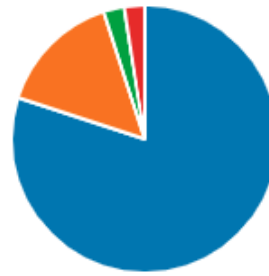

Teachers always seem happy to take time to discuss any concerns. My children are always happy to come to school and seem very settled and talk fondly of their teachers and other staff. I do worry about how they will transition from such a supportive, protected, school community to secondary school, but that's a future problem. One suggestion would be to see if there is a way of getting us parents more involved and connected, that work long hours. With my children being in club morning and afternoon due to this, I can feel out of the loop and like they miss out on socialising outside of school due to me not coming into contact with other parents and not having social media. I'm not sure how this could be done though. Also, could there be a way of giving staff dojo points or the equivalent??</p>
