Thursday 6th March is World Book Day! Here's what we've got planned.

Dressing up

We'd like to invite the children to come to school dressed as a word. The possibilities for this are endless! Here are some tips:

D Character costumes are welcome. Ask your child to think of a word that describes their character. For example, Sleeping Beauty could be 'drowsy.'

A Think about jobs: scientist, farmer, hair dresser. If your child loves the books of Adam Kay, doctor could be the word for them!

🗊 Creatures! Dragon, yeti, ogre, goblin, gorgon, unicorn, gargoyle, weeping angel, fairy.

Nationalities: pop on a pair of German lederhosen, a Scottish kilt or a Japanese kimono.

C Don't forget the adjectives: bright, bold, colourful, preppy! If your child is struggling to make a decision, starting with their favourite outfit then finding a word to match is an easier option.

If your child would prefer just to come in their uniform, that's perfectly ok too.

Design a plate competition

Each child has been given a plate to design with their favourite book, character or author. They can use felt tips, paint, collage – whatever they like! We'll display all of their creations in the hall and there will be a prize for the winner of each year group. These can be brought in to school on the day or before. Please make sure that your child's name and year group are written on the back of the plate as well as their chosen book, character or author.

World Book Day Vouchers
