



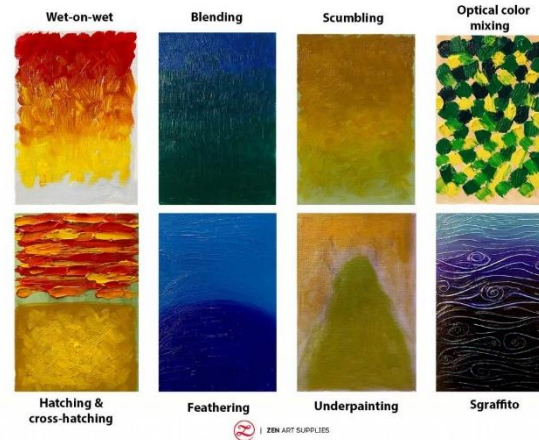

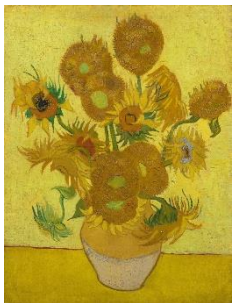

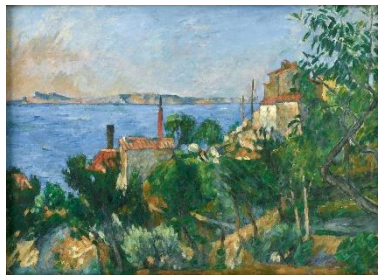

Vocabulary:

Word	Definition
Impressionism	Impressionism is a style of painting that focuses on the effects of light and atmosphere on colours and forms. Impressionist artists often used broken brush strokes rather than smooth and unnoticeable ones and also used many colours to paint scenes of every day life.
Post Impressionism	The word "Post-" means "after", so "post-impressionist" painting came after "impressionist" painting. These artists developed impressionism but rejected its limitations. They continued using the real-life subject matter, with vivid colours, often with thick paint.
Stroke	A mark made by drawing a pen, pencil, or paintbrush in one direction across paper or canvas.
Appliqué	Ornamental needlework in which pieces of fabric are sewn or stuck on to a larger piece to form a picture or pattern.
