


Minibeasts are 'small creatures', like worms, snails, insects and spiders. The scientific term for them is 'invertebrates' – a creature without a backbone. Because they don't have a backbone, minibeasts tend to have other structures which support and protect them.	A microhabitat is a very small part of a habitat, such as a clump of grass or a space between rocks.
