#### **COMMUNICATION IDEAS**

- Website! More information on the website. The school website needs an overhaul.

- Open playground in the morning.
- More verbal face to face contact.
- More notice for things.
- Facebook page.
- Rather than 3 or 4 texts one after the other. Perhaps one with all the information on.
- More explanation & structure to the homework set timelines & notes to/from Parents. Esther is usually great at this so use her as a benchmark.
- More face to face interception with parents. Emails with more explanations behind changes than given in very succinct texts. Changes to teaching staff & timelines/structures needs to be communicated at the outset. If we get things explained as developed rather than 'Chinese Whispers'.
- Let staff know of things going off and not giving just a two minute warning.
- Would like to know more about timetable I am not clear which days trainers are needed etc. In Chatsworth there is no incentive to fill in the reading record & I haven't seen it in a while.
- I like that we have so many dates for the year already.
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## **TEACHING TO OUR STRENGTHS COMMENTS**

- I really like this idea and it means that the children are comfortable with all the teachers & won't mind moving up.
- Good & stable routine. Like it!

- Great idea.
- I welcome the idea but with the limited amount of staff engaged & the length of time the teachers can work (part-time basis for most staff). This is limited in reality eg. Teaching assistant teaching French not Miss O'Shea. teaching

### **HELP IN SCHOOL COMMENTS**

- Getting parents involved is a massive thing! We need more Parent Helpers and parent/staff communication. This works 'both ways', it's not just up to teachers to communicate!
- 'Friends of Fritchley' I think you will get more parents engaged if they know what they are doing/when and why no feedback has been communicated on fundraising events. How many I-pads do we need? How many did we buy or what is the shortfall? Everything is lastminute.com.
- Parents can help from home with their own children if guided ie better communication on receiving guidance/homework. We need to think about different ways to engage parent, not just coming into school at set times.
- Happy to help organise events.
- Could we do reading by getting several parents in together so that more children read individually?
- Specific big charities e.g. Children in Need, Sports Relief and pick a small local charity annually to support.
- Could silver coin donation days make a contribution to a different charity each time? Perhaps the children could nominate a charity.
