





<div><div><div>Monday 3rd September 1666</div><div>The fire gets very close to the Tower of London.</div></div><div><div>Tuesday 4th September 1666</div><div>St Paul's Cathedral is destroyed by the fire.</div></div><div>Timeline of Events</div></div>				
<div><div><div>Sunday 2nd September 1666</div><div>The fire starts at around 1 a.m. Mid-morning: Samuel Pepys starts to write about the fire in his diary.</div></div><div><div>Wednesday 5th September 1666</div><div>The wind dies down and the fire spreads more slowly.</div></div><div><div>Thursday 6th September 1666</div><div>The fire is finally put out. Thousands of people are left homeless.</div></div></div>
