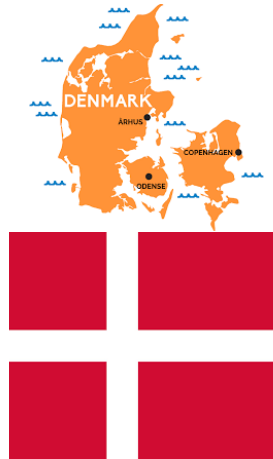
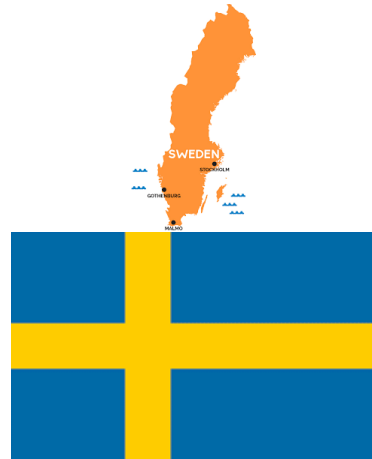
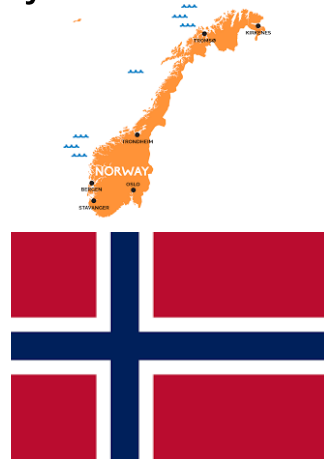

Archipelago	an area that contains a chain or group of islands scattered in lakes, rivers, or the ocean
