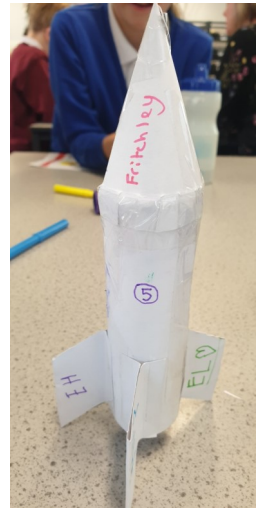

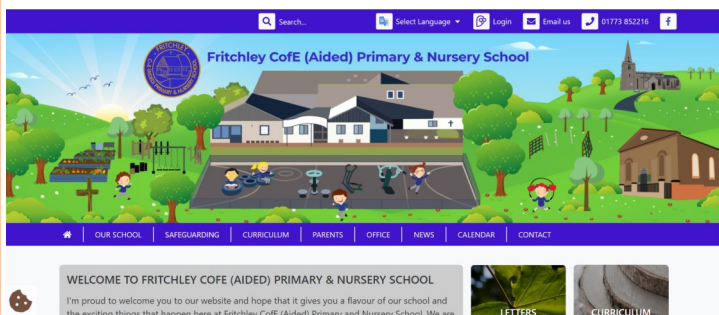
Year 5 Science Day at David Nieper Academy

School Website and Parent Pay

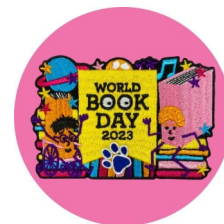
