After February half term Hardwick will be learning 'What grows from an egg?' as their topic. To enhance childrens' learning we would like to take the class to White Post Farm in Nottinghamshire for a guided tour and learning experience. Children will be able to feed, pet and hold some of the animals on the farm and learn lots of new information.

We will be travelling by coach and will be leaving school shortly after 9am and returning at 3:30pm. Due to the increased costs of transport, this trip will cost £20 per child, which has been partly subsidised by the school PTFA.
