

2025/26 Sports Funding Grant

Planned use of Sports Funding Grant: 2025/26.

In April 2013, the government announced new funding of £150 million for physical education (PE) and sport, to be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sports provision. Funding was allocated to all maintained and state-funded schools with primary phase pupils from September 2013. Fritchley CofE (Aided) Primary and Nursery School is receiving £16,651 in 2025/26 for the PE sports grant. Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of sports provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.
