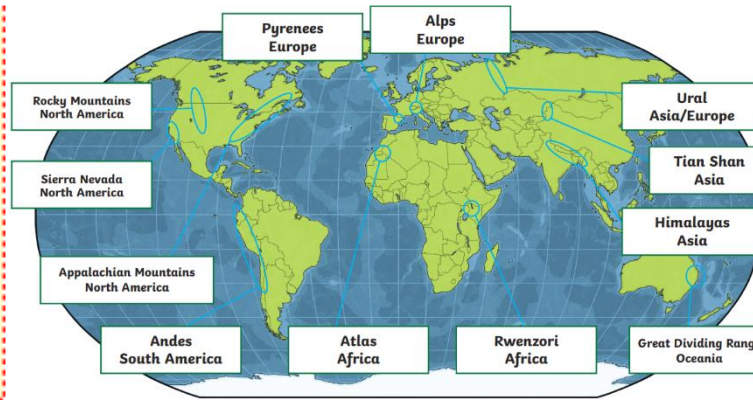
Vocabulary:

Mountains	
Mountain range	A group of mountains
Topographic	Mapping of a region
Erosion	Destruction of rock by rivers, sea or weather
Fold	A bend in the rock
Fault block	A fracture in rock
Summit	Highest point of a mountain or hill

Mountain ranges of the world

Valley	a low area of land between mountains/hills
<b>Rivers</b>	
Groundwater	
Evaporation	Transition from liquid to gas
Precipitation	Rain, snow, sleet or hail
Condensation	Group of water droplets
River mouth	The end of a river where it meets other water
Meander	The turns in a river
Estuary	Where freshwater meets saltwater
Source	The start of a river
Floodplain	Flat area of land next to river or stream
Tributaries	Small river that flows into a big river
